



# Hammock Dunes Cycling Group By Sandi Heber


The Hammock Dunes Cycling Group was started some three years ago under the stewardship of Sandi Heber and Roger Leverton. Since those early days the group has grown in numbers and widened its range of runs.

Every Sunday morning, at 8 o'clock prompt, a group of ten or more cyclists meet at the back gates of Hammock Dunes and sets out to enjoy some of the 100 miles of cycling trails that traverse Flagler County. Typical runs are 25/30 miles and vary from cycling to Marineland / Matanzas Outlet in the north, to taking the Highbridge Loop in the south. Recent additions have been the opening up of the Graham Swamp and Lehigh Trails between Colbert Road and US 1. Once over the Intracoastal Bridges, the cycling is on safe, flat pathways; often passing through beautifully wooded, sheltered, conservation areas or running alongside the Intracoastal Waterway.

Towards the end of each run, breakfast is enjoyed at one of the many good eateries found in the Flagler Beach/Palm Coast area.


Carol Hasan, a long-time member of the group, says "I really look forward to my cycle ride each Sunday. I enjoy both the exercise and great camaraderie of the group".





# TASTY TIPS

Can you grill frozen lamp chops?

Rico: Ideally defrost the lamb chops overnight in the refrigerator. Pat dry with paper towels before cooking. Grilling frozen lamb chops will take longer and the meat might be tough compared to defrosted chops.

What is BHT or Butylated hydroxytoluene?

Vinnie: BHT Is an antioxidant food additive used to prevent change of color or taste and to help extend the shelf life of foods. It has been know to cause abdominal pain and interfere with liver function. It is best to avoid foods that contain BHT.

What are the different methods of ripening tomatoes?

Rico: There are a few ways to speed the ripening process of tomatoes. You can place one large banana in a wide mouth mason jar. Add up to four medium or six small green tomatoes in the jar. Bananas

speedup the ripening process of the tomato. Make sure the lid is on tight. Place the jar on the counter top near the stove. Check once or twice a day to make sure the banana has not turned rotten. If this happens, replace the banana with a fresh one until the tomatoes have ripened. Another method to get good ripened tomatoes is take a medium size cardboard box and line it with newspaper. Place the green tomatoes in a layers on the bottom of the box. If you have more tomatoes that need to be ripened, you can add layers in the cardboard box. Make sure you place newspaper between the layers. Store in a cool place until ripened. Plastic bags can be used in the same way as the cardboard box, however, it is necessary to put holes in the bag for air circulation. It is important that you do not put too many tomatoes in the bag; three or four at the most. A paper bag is a great way to ripen tomatoes when you only have a few tomatoes. Place tomatoes in a paper bag with a banana. Keep the bag open and store in a warm place.

Decisions... decisions. Choosing which golf course to play at the Hammock Dunes Club can be tough because both the Links and the Creek Courses are outstanding tracks. Before the Creek Course was built, golfers at Hammock Dunes only had one option, the Links Course. But what a course! I was reminded of how terrific the Links Course is last summer when the Creek Course was closed for three months. Teeing it up at the Links numerous times a week was a real treat; and thanks to its wonderful design and the constantly changing winds, never boring. I started wondering about the course architect and what his thought process was in laying out the course. Dan Pontes, our Hammock Dunes Club Head Professional, dug up an old Links Course guide and yardage book that included some interesting information.

Designed by Tom Fazio, the Links Course opened for play in 1989. It has stood the test of time and after 23 years, remains one of the best courses in the state. Fazio's oceanside layout meanders through the Hammock Dunes community. The landscaping and attention to detail make the course routing feel like a series of beautiful postcards. With several holes overlooking the majestic Atlantic Ocean, the property is without question, breathtaking. The windswept layout offers exceptional playability, matched only by the scenery. This environment lends itself to play for

all levels of players and provides for a pleasant and challenging round on this gem of a course.

#### A Special Place in So Many Ways

Wildlife is in abundance at the Links Course and the Club takes great pride in preserving and protecting it. Thanks to Bob Haley, back in 2001, Audubon International designated the Links Course as a Certified Audubon Cooperative Sanctuary. Hammock Dunes Club is one of less than a dozen communities throughout the nation to have two or more Audubon certified golf courses.

Another reason the Links Course is so special is how different it plays from each of the four sets of tees. The ladies really enjoy the layout from the Red

# **Cruising Tips**

Over the last years, my wife Pat and I have taken the opportunity to do a lot of cruising! We have been on the well known larger lines like Royal Caribbean and Carnival as well as the smaller and more luxurious lines such as Oceania and Regent Seven Seas. If you have an interest in taking a cruise, hopefully this article can steer you in the right direction.

First off, there are cruise ports in Port Canaveral, Fort Lauderdale and Miami that will allow you to drive to your cruise. Very helpful if you want to take the kitchen sink as well as your entire closet. Carnival, Royal Caribbean and Celebrity offer short cruises (5 -12 days) all year. The smaller, more expensive lines generally have "drive to" cruises that can range from 7 days to 2 months- usually in the late fall to mid spring. Caribbean cruising is a great way to get warm in the winter. Generally the ports visited aren't show stoppers, but some of the smaller lines get into out of the way anchorages in the Virgin Islands that are fabulous. The longer cruises available in state will take you to the southern Caribbean and also through the Panama Canal (extremely interesting) on their way to either South America or the Mexican western coast and California. If you are willing to fly to your cruise, then you can take advantage of perhaps the easiest way to tour a number of cities and countries without packing and unpacking your bags! Your hotel takes you there and, oh by the way, feeds you too. And it's paid for in advance. In my opinion, the best way to see Europe.



The choice of cruise lines can get complicated. Generally, the larger ships (2,000+ passengers) offer more onboard activities such as rock climbing walls and ice rinks and more elaborate nightly entertainment at a lower price. Great if you're taking the grandkids along.

However, the drawbacks include having to pay for shore excursions as well as alcoholic beverages. Most of the large ships have "reservation only" dining venues where the quality of food and service is better but there is always a \$30-50 up charge per person.

The smaller, more upscale cruise lines all have very good food and service. They are not "adults only" but you do not see many children - they would get bored! As you would expect, there are differences. Regent Seven Seas includes just about everything in their cruise fares including most excursions. But the per night / per person charge is on the high side. Seabourne includes everything except excursions while Azamara and Oceania charge you for alcoholic beverages. Oceania also does not include gratuities. A word about ship excursions. They are an easy and convenient way to see the sights. However, they are expensive (usually twice what you can arrange on

## **Approaching Tough Conversations** With Information and Support

Sometimes the most difficult conversations are the most important ones to have with our loved ones. As society ages and health care technology and resources change, each of us may find ourselves needing to address difficult medical decisions with loved ones, including end-of-life care planning.

Kathleen Moore A ready source of guidance and support for such conversations is Florida Hospital HospiceCare which has been providing services since 1996. Their skilled and compassionate staff and volunteers walk this journey daily with their patients and caregivers.

Suggestions to start discussions with family members include locating an appropriate quiet, private setting, remembering that you are there to listen with respect and care, and sometimes including a professional advisor. While advance care planning can elicit strong, sometimes fearful emotions in all of us, the team at Florida Hospital HospiceCare has repeatedly seen the relief families experience once critical decisions have been made.

"Conversations that are difficult to initiate often result in great relief, and even bring family members closer together," said social worker Harry Humphrey. The specialized training of the Florida Hospital HospiceCare team allows them to listen without judgement, advise on best ways to approach family conversations and act as advocates for patients and caregivers with other health care providers.



Vineyards of Durnstein

We continue our Tauck Riverboat trip down the Blue Danube from Prague, Czech Republic to Germany to Budapest, Hungary.

and funded in great part by wine revenue.





Tees. The men have three sets of tees to choose from - all presenting different challenges. But beware! If you venture back to the Gold Tees, Fazio has you playing a 6,757 yard par 72 links with a 73.7 course rating and a slope of 141. One only has to look at the four Par 3 holes that average more than 200 yards to know the degree of difficulty is on the high side. Now add in mother nature and the Links Course is a true test for even the best of golfers.

#### The Art of Tom Fazio

One of the most highly acclaimed talents in the world of golf design, Tom Fazio, has been creating championship courses for more than four decades.

Over the years his work has earned him countless honors. In one Golf Digest poll, Fazio was hailed as one of the top golf course architects of our time. He has been named Golf Course Architect of the Year five times by readers of Golf Course News. And one year, Fazio designs swept "Best New Course in America" awards in the Private, Resort and Public categories.


touch the sine...it doesn't belong to the terrain of the course, and yet the wind has a lot to do with how the holes were designed and how these holes are played."

"After that, the predominance of the ocean at the site and the sensitive areas of the course-hammocks of oak trees and wetlands - became important factors in placing the golf course in the ground."

"Hammock Dunes is a very special place. The Links is a world class course on a world class piece of land. I hope you enjoy playing it as much as I enjoyed designing it."

Former PGA Tour Professional and current Senior Tour Player, Fred Funk, holds the Links Course record from the Gold Tees. Back in September 1995, Fred shot a 64. Now that is something special to shoot for!

# **Skin Cancer Detection & Removal**

Skin cancer is the most common form of cancer in the US and affects over a million people each year. This condition involves an abnormal growth of skin cells that can form anywhere on the body, although it most commonly affects skin that is exposed to the sun. Most cases of skin cancer can be successfully treated through minimally invasive procedures.



The best type of treatment for skin cancer depends on the type, size and location of the tumor. Most cases are removed surgically, through an outpatient procedure that requires only local anesthesia. # Drive it Longer and Straighter....Part 2

### Stop the Chop!

We have all heard the saying "Drive for Show, Putt for Dough". While the short game is extremely important to lowering your scores, if you are not driving the ball well, you are setting yourself up to have a long day on the links. Hopefully, the Merry-Go-Round image is starting to take hold from my previous article. Now we want to focus on learning to fly. Picture a plane moving down the runway and taking off. Now imagine the picture of a plane landing. Our driver swing should copy that of plane taking the passengers away from the airport, not returning them back from their trip. To achieve this shallow angle of approach and subsequent ascending position post impact, the club must travel from the inside. You may notice your arms close to your pants pocket as you swing the club on the way down, and then swinging out away from your body toward the ball. Focus on making this move with the arms, not the shoulders or body. The goal is to have your club head path level or slightly ascending as opposed to descending and "chopping" into the ball on a steep angle. Combine a more rounded swing plane, a shallower path and a level strike through the ball and you too will see improved distance and accuracy in your drives!



"Grandgirl's" Fresh Apple Cake

Preheat oven to 325 degrees

Cake ingredients:

2 cups sugar

3 large eggs

1 ½ cups vegetable oil

1/4 cup orange juice (no pulp)

3 cups all-purpose flour

1 teaspoon baking soda

1/4 teaspoon salt

1 tablespoon cinnamon

1 tablespoon vanilla extract

3 cups peeled and finely chopped tart apples

1 cup shredded coconut

1 cup chopped pecans

Generously grease a Bundt pan. Combine cake ingredients in a large bowl in the order given and mix well. Pour batter into the prepared pan and bake for approximately 1  $\frac{1}{2}$  hours. Near the end of the baking time check the cake and do not overcook as it will dry the cake out.

Remove cake from oven and let cool 10 minutes. Remove cake from pan - place on wire rack.

Sauce ingredients: ½ cup butter (1 stick) 1 cup sugar ½ cup buttermilk ½ teaspoon baking soda 1 tablespoon corn syrup


