**Between** Robert V. Patrick and Virginia R. Patrick, his wife, of

County, a corporation organized and existing under and by virtue  
of the laws of the State of New Jersey, party  
of the second part;

**Whereas,** the said Robert V. Patrick  
in and by a certain OBLIGATION or writing obligatory, under his hand and  
seal duly executed, and bearing even date herewith, stands bound unto the said party of the  
second part, in the sum of Seven Thousand Dollars (\$7000.00) lawful money  
of the United States of America, conditioned for the payment, in  
lawful money as aforesaid, of the just sum of Thirty-five Hundred  
Dollars (\$3500.00), in one year from the date thereof, together  
with interest thereon at the rate of five per centum per annum,  
payable semi-annually, clear of all taxes and assessments,
