





Ramiro Garzon, MD

Tamiro Garzon is an Assistant Professor of Medicine in the Division of Hematology, Department of Internal Medicine and a member of the Molecular Biology and Cancer Genetics program at The Ohio State University Comprehensive Cancer Center, Columbus, Ohio, USA. He received his M.D. from the National University School of Medicine, Cordoba, Argentina. He trained in the internal medicine program at Danbury Hospital, Connecticut and subsequently completed a hematology and oncology fellowship at Thomas Jefferson University, Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and a leukemia fellowship at The Ohio State University. His research focuses on microRNA (miRNA) expression and function in normal hematopoiesis and leukemia. In particular, he is interested in dissecting the role of miRNAs in aberrant epigenetics and in developing novel miRNA-based therapies. He has made several original contributions in the field of miRNAs and leukemia, including the first evidence that miRNAs target the DNA methylation machinery. In 2008, he received the prestigious Kimmel Translational Award to help develop miRNA-based therapeutics to target aberrant epigenetics in acute myeloid leukemia (AML). He has published more than 60 peer-reviewed articles and is the principal investigator of several federal research grants.
